CONDITIONS RELATING TO THE EXHIBITION OF
POULTRY, PIGEONS, RABBITS, CAVIES and CAGE & AVIARY

1. In classes with less than three entries, the committee will at its discretion amalgamate that class.
2. Every exhibitor will be held responsible for the correctness of his entries and statements on the entry form.
3. No Exhibit of a breed with a class already provided will be allowed to compete in classes scheduled for "Any Other Variety".
4. All exhibits to be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.
5. The Society will take reasonable care for the safety of the exhibits, and for any other property entrusted to them, but it must be distinctly understood by the Exhibitor of any exhibits and all other persons, that the committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss, or at the show, whether arising from accident, or any other cause whatsoever, nor for any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants, or others, and it is on this understanding only that entries and claims are received, and Exhibitors will be required to hold the Society harmless in the event of any loss.
6. No person may handle, pen or repack any exhibit without the permission of the Stewards in charge.
7. SPECIAL NOTE: Exhibitors are particularly requested to note that exhibits must be penned by 9.30am prompt for judging to commence at 10.00am.
8. Feeding and watering of birds (after judging has taken place) will be sole responsibility of the owner.
9. All Prize Money in the Pigeon, Cage & Aviary, Cavy and Rabbit Sections will be paid on Show Day (except in the case of protest).
10. All exhibits must remain staged until 5pm on Show Day when all persons will be required to leave the F & F marquee, and only those who present their removal order will be allowed to re-enter. Any exhibitor, agent, or servant attempting to remove any exhibit before 5pm, unless they have an early removal order, or in any way contravening this regulation, will be expelled from the tent and may be required to forfeit all prizes that may have been awarded to his exhibits, or to those of which he may be in charge.
11. All Perpetual Cups and Trophies must be returned to the section secretary on or before 31st July the following year – at the Exhibitors expense. Engraving may be carried out at the exhibitor's expense.
12. A Steward of the Society will remain in charge of the Fur & Feather Marquee throughout the Show, for the protection of Exhibits.
13. Free Exhibitors pass will be given with entries totalling £5 or more, £2 for juniors.
14. The committee has the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
15. STRICTLY NO ENTRIES AFTER THE CLOSING DATE AGREED BY THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE.
